United States Commercial Slaughter

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 5.02 billion pounds in October 2024, up 5 percent from the 4.77 billion pounds produced in October 2023.

Beef production, at 2.47 billion pounds, was 5 percent above the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 2.86 million head, up 1 percent from October 2023.

Veal production totaled 3.30 million pounds, 21 percent below October a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 17,100 head, down 26 percent from October 2023.

Pork production totaled 2.54 billion pounds, up 5 percent from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 11.9 million head, up 4 percent from October 2023.

Lamb and mutton production, at 11.7 million pounds, was up 4 percent from October 2023. Sheep slaughter totaled 194,700 head, slightly above last year.

Pacific Region Commercial Slaughter

California's production of red meat during October 2024 totaled 101 million pounds (dressed weight), 7 percent below than October 2023. This figure includes slaughter in Federally-inspected and state-inspected plants, but excludes farm slaughter. In October 2024, the average live weight of cattle slaughtered in California was 1,372 pounds, sheep and lambs averaged 148 pounds, and hogs averaged 233 pounds. In Hawaii, 800,000 pounds of red meat were produced in October 2024, and 100,000 pounds of red meat were produced in Nevada.
